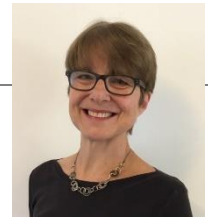

Anthea Millar MA, MBACP (Senior Accredited), UKRC, Dip. IIP

Anthea Millar is a UK based senior accredited Adlerian psychotherapist, psychotherapy trainer and supervisor/supervisor educator, with 35 years' experience working in the National Health Service, with Employee Assistance Programs, and numerous social service, educational and charitable agencies. Anthea founded the 4 year Adlerian counselling Diploma training in Cambridge 30 years ago and she also supports other Adlerian training programs both in the UK and abroad. This has included providing trauma therapy training in Lithuania, Latvia, Romania, Bulgaria, Greece, Israel, Malta, Canada, the USA and Malaysia.

A first career from 1973 as a speech and language therapist, when she specialized in neurological trauma, set the scene for her interest in psychological as well as physical trauma, for which she has undergone many longer specialized trainings.

She is a Vice-President of the Adlerian Society of the UK, co-editor of the UK journal, and on the faculty and board of ICASSI, the international Adler/Dreikurs summer school, where her teaching specialism is in trauma work and supervision. As co-founder and partner of Cambridge Supervision Training, www.cambridgesupervisiontraining.org high quality assessed supervision training is an important area of focus. She is co-author of 'Practical Supervision: How to become a Supervisor for the Helping Professions' and has also written many other chapters and articles on trauma, supervision and Adlerian psychology.
